First Day Information

Students that still need to pick up their schedules on Tuesday, August 21 will need to report to the cafeteria. All other students are to report directly to the gymnasium with their book bags. After a short kickoff students will be dismissed to their lockers prior to going to first hour.

Bus Information:

Bus stop locations and route numbers are now available on Home Access. Please be sure to check Home Access to verify all stop information..

- Please make sure to have your student at their assigned bus stop location 5 minutes prior to their designated time.

Parking Lot Procedures:

Morning Drop Off

- Make an immediate right upon entering campus. Follow the drive to the front of the building, follow the signs and the directions of the staff member on duty. Move forward as far as possible prior to dropping off your student.
- Students should exit the car on the right hand side onto the sidewalk.
- Parents should maintain a single file line along the curb during drop off. **Please do not attempt to pass other cars on the left to exit once your student has exited the car.**
- **If you prefer to use the parking lot for pick up or drop off, please park your car and walk your student across the crosswalk. Due to all of the traffic entering and exiting the parking lot we want to ensure all students are safe.**

Afternoon Pick Up

- Make an immediate right upon entering campus. Follow the drive to the front of the building, follow the signs and the directions of the staff member on duty. Move forward as far as possible prior to dropping off your student.
- Students should enter the car on the right hand side from the sidewalk. **Students can be picked up from the sidewalk only and may not use the grass portion of the property to enter a vehicle.**
- Parents should maintain a single file line along the curb during pick up. **Please do not drive in or attempt to pick up or pass other cars in the left lane.**
- **If you prefer to use the parking lot for pick up or drop off, please park your car and meet your student at the crosswalk. A staff member will escort your student across the crosswalk to ensure his/her safety.**
