# Walkers

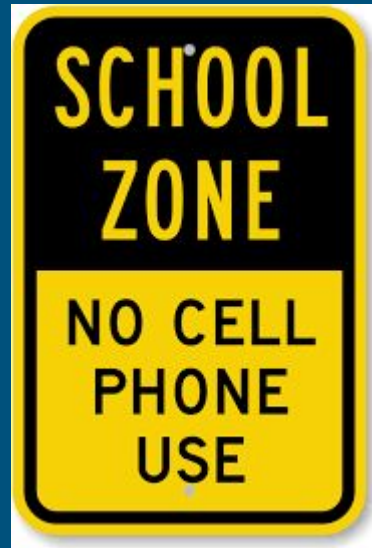
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- Identify a safe walking path and practice this route prior to the start of school.
- Determine how much time you will need to walk to school in order to get to class on time.
  - School doors open at 7:50am
  - School begins at 8:00am
- Walk to school in a group. Coordinate with other students in your neighborhood who walk to school.
- Be aware of passing cars when crossing the street.
- Use the marked crosswalks.
- Use the sidewalk.
- Be aware of your interactions.



# Drop-off Line

- Follow your schools drop-off and pick-up procedures as communicated.
- Determine how much time you will need to get to school. Weather conditions can cause traffic, as well as increase the amount of time you may wait in the drop-off line.
  - School doors open at 7:50am
  - School begins at 8:00am
- Parents be aware of
  - School speed zone
  - Other vehicles and bus zones
  - Local traffic, including construction zones
  - Other local school traffic
  - Students walking or riding bikes to school
  - Review school zone safety signs.



# Bicycle

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- Identify a safe bike route and practice this route prior to the start of school.
- Determine how much time you will need to travel to school in order to get to class on time.
  - School doors open at 7:50am
  - School begins at 8:00am
- Bike to school in a group. Coordinate with other students in your neighborhood who ride their bikes to school.
- Wear protective gear like helmets and knee/elbow pads.
- Wear bright clothing or other high visibility clothing like a vest or armband.
- Be aware of your interactions

# Bus

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- The bus is an extension of the classroom.
  - Follow the directions of the driver
  - Remain in your seat
  - Voice level should only be loud enough for the person you are sitting with to hear you.
- Locate your pick-up and drop-off locations and times through the Home Access Center.
- Arrive to your bus stop 5 minutes prior to the posted pick-up time.
- Do not cross in front of the bus.
- To ride another bus you must present written permission from your parent/guardian to the office. An administrator must approve of this temporary change and will provide you with a form you will present to the driver.

# Bus

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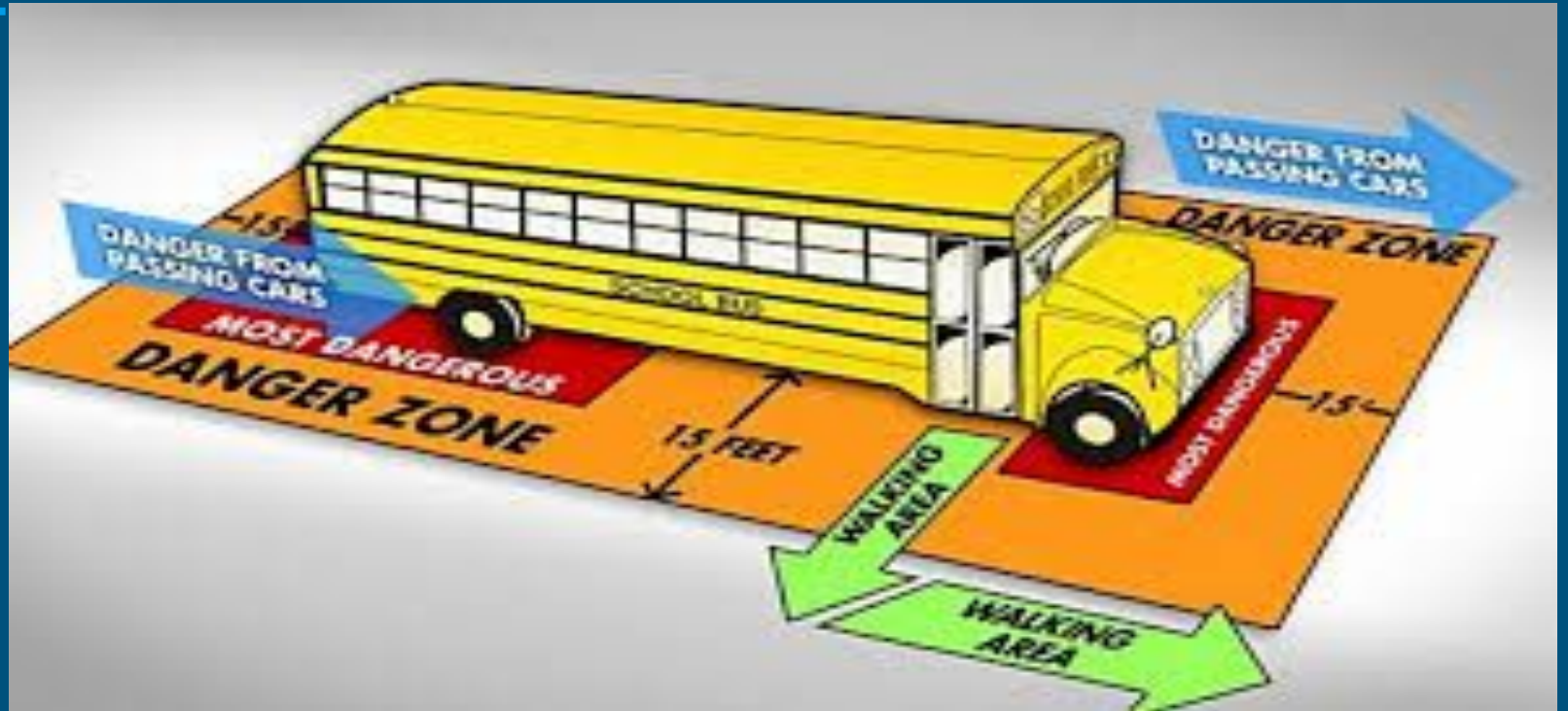
**Bus entrances** - Please use the following grade level assigned doors

- 6th grade - door #6
- 7th grade - door #7
- 8th grade - door # 10
- Breakfast - door #11

## **Bus Evacuation**

- Know where Emergency Exits are located.
- Follow directions of the driver
- A Granger administrator will arrive to help coordinate parent pick-up.
