Safety Drill Best Practices

Why do we do safety drills?

- To ensure that all students and staff are as safe as possible
- To be prepared for events not just in school, but our daily lives

What are some proactive safety practices?

- Have a heightened sense of awareness and be present in the moment
- Use your senses to be more aware of your surroundings...and not just in school (walking home from school, at the movies or the mall, at home...)

Be aware/present

- Know where you are, know your location
- Know where the Exits are located
- Know safe places within your environment and use specific and detailed information if calling for help

Alert

- Alert an adult about the situation (Fire, Tornado, stranger danger, threatening behavior, medical issue...)
- Safely provide as much detail about the situation as you possibly can

Inform

- The office will provide as much clear and accurate information as possible based on the alert (location, people involved, potential next steps)

What are the behavior expectations?

- Be Quiet and Listen (Follow your teacher's directions and instructions)
- Observe your surroundings (STOP, LOOK and LISTEN)
- Remain calm and listen for updates and announcements
- Stay away from doors and windows

ALICE,ALICE,ALICE

- **Alert**-Tell everyone what is going on
- **Lockdown**-Lock doors, barricade, stay quiet and out of sight
- **Inform**-Keep telling everyone what is going on, be specific and detailed
- **Counter**-Do what you can to be safe
- **Evacuate**-Get out of the building and get to a safe location
- What is the danger, and where is the danger?
